GARDEN IN THE WOODS

- Tour guide for adult or children's groups.** Choose weekdays, weekends, or a combination. Ten-hour training program provided in the spring.
- Garden in the Woods Greeter.** Pass out maps, provide information and orientation to our visitors, weekends from mid-April to July. Volunteer once a month or as you are able.
- Library.** Volunteer once a week throughout the year or as your schedule permits. Computer skills appreciated.
- Membership/Development or Marketing Assistant.** Apply your special skills to these worthy areas for the Society. Computer skills appreciated.

REGIONALLY IN NEW ENGLAND

- Nasami Farm.** Assist with plant propagation at our native plant nursery in Whately, MA.
